Join the **Hudson Highlands Land Trust** for a conservation science study and an off-trail walk! We'll be learning about the deer population on our new property, **Granite Mountain Preserve**. Explore the woods in teams, while walking one or more half-mile-long transects to estimate the density of deer per square mile. Expect to walk at least two miles on rough terrain. Best for adult volunteers; students age 12+ welcome with an adult guardian.
